 - Does the Level 2 Strategic Flood Risk Assessment for Goole (2020) (the L2 SFRA) (document EXAM1H) use appropriate inputs relating to river levels, the breach period and the breach invert level?
 - What are the key results of the L2 SFRA (2020) and how do they compare to other recent studies in the area?
 - Does the flood risk evidence show that housing allocations in Goole are not a reasonable spatial option for development?
 - What are the implications of the flood risk evidence for windfall housing and other types of development in Goole?
- 3. Approach to housing growth in Hedon
 - Are parts of sites HED-3, 4, 5, 6, 11 and 13 located in Flood Zone 3a, in addition to site HED-8?
 - Why were these sites not appraised as reasonable alternatives in the site assessment process?

- If site options in breach and overtopping regions can be made safe in terms of flood risk for their lifetime (as referred to in paragraph M6 in the Council's Hearing Statement), why were they not appraised as reasonable alternatives in the site assessment process?
- Why does the Council conclude that sustainability benefits of development on these sites would not outweigh the risk of flooding, and therefore the second part of the exceptions test would not be met? (as set out in paragraph M6 in the Council's Hearing Statement)
- How would the two new flood alleviation schemes in the Hedon area, as referred to in paragraph M3 in the Council's Hearing Statement, impact on the assessment of flood risk around the town?
- Has the strategic approach of resisting further housing development on the edge of Hedon been subject to Sustainability Appraisal?
- 4. Justification for the strategic approach of resisting further housing development on the edge of Gilberdyke/Newport, Leven, Stamford Bridge, Bilton, Dunswell, Rawcliffe, Thorngumbald, Tickton and Woodmansey
 - Justification in relation to the flood risk villages
 - Levels of recent housing growth in Stamford Bridge and Woodmansey and how it compares to recent housing growth in other settlements
 - What is the Local Highways Authority's position on further housing development in Stamford Bridge and which site options have fundamental constraints relating to heritage and ecology?
 - Employment development in Woodmansey
 - Have the three strategies to resist housing allocations on the edge of the above villages been subject to Sustainability Appraisal?
