- Car Parking:** There is a car park (with limited spaces) along Church Road a short walk from the House.
- Cycle parking:** Available to the right of Shaw House.
- Public Transport:** Shaw House is approx. 25min walk from Newbury Railway Station. Alternatively, the *jet black* bus service runs from Newbury Bus Station to Shaw Road, a 5min walk from Shaw House.
- Refreshments:** There is a café on site which offers a range of sandwiches, cakes, snacks & hot & cold drinks. Tea & coffee will be available to purchase throughout the day and water will be available in the Great Hall.

*Please note that it is not possible to place an order for lunch, so if you would like to purchase lunch from the café it is recommended you do so when you first arrive to guarantee availability.*

- On arrival:** Please sign in using the sign in sheets just outside the Great Hall.
